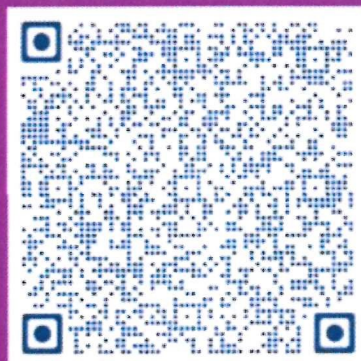
Autism central is here to help!
