



Richard Hale School Sixth Form Options for entry September 2026

For A Levels – choose three subjects, each from a different block. *Further Maths may be chosen as a fourth, if you are also doing Maths.*

For BTEC – choose one subject.

For Enrichment Courses – students can choose one of these in addition to their A-Levels or BTEC Course (optional). The Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) may be taken either as a standalone course or alongside another enrichment option.

Entry requirements for A Levels: Average Points Score of 5.0 across your GCSEs in addition to English Language and Mathematics GCSE at grade 5 or more. A Grade 6 in the subjects you wish to study at A Level (or a related subject). **Entry requirements for A Levels (x2) and an AAQ (Alternative Academic Qualification) in Applied Science requires 4.5+ Average Points Score across your GCSEs, in addition to English and Mathematics GCSE.

Entry requirements for BTEC Courses: Average Points Score of 4.0 across your GCSEs in addition to English Language and Mathematics at Grade 4 or more.
